## Paediatric Update Symposium, 2023

### Call for Proposals

The organizing committee for the 2023 Paediatric Update Symposium is planning an in-person 2-day conference **June 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in Vancouver, BC** (exact location TBA). We are pleased to announce a call for proposals. There are 3 categories for proposal submission:

#### 1. **Poster**

- There will be a specific poster viewing area, with dedicated time for attendees to view and interact with authors.

#### 2. **BC Practice Profile**

- A brief 10-minute synopsis of a BC based program, service, or research project highlighting local work being done by BC clinicians/researchers. This is done in a panel format with 4-5 profiles, followed by a question period from the attendees.

#### 3. **Profession Specific and/or Topic Specific Break-Out Sessions**

- Longer sessions (typically 60-90 minutes) with the intent to provide a more interactive workshop type opportunity. Attendees will be able to select which session they would like to attend. Please indicate how long you anticipate your session will be.

### Submission Guidelines

Your submissions should include the following:

- Title, Description, Rationale
- 300 words max. The description section should include the learning objectives, and a description of the presentation. The rationale section should include details regarding the importance of this information to the paediatric rehabilitation community.
- Indicate your top 2 preferred presentation category formats
