



Trauma Informed Practice and Cultural Safety Training

The Ministry of Child and Family Development (MCFD) is investing in training to improve the skills and knowledge of front-line service providers, program managers, administrators, and Executive Directors of agencies that contract with MCFD to deliver foundational programs for children and youth with special needs.

Travel and Accommodation Support

Funds are available to support attendance at the regional workshops.

Driving- If you have to drive a distance of greater than 30km one way to attend a workshop, you are eligible for travel compensation. At the end of the 2-day workshop please submit a copy of a receipt following filling your fuel tank. If the distance you were required to drive to attend the workshop is greater than 300km one way, you are eligible to submit 2 receipts following filling your fuel tank. All gas receipts submitted to jason@bcacdi.org.

Flying – Funds are available for those attendees that had to travel a significant distance to attend a workshop and chose to fly. You will have to purchase your flight and then submit your receipt. All flight receipts are to be submitted to jason@bcacdi.org following attendance at the regional workshop.

I will meet with our book keeper at the end of February and the end of March to process workshop travel support expenses. Please allow 4 weeks for reimbursement.
